Haiti Plunge Inc. hosted its first Seamless Team Reunion on August 1, 2015. After 31 years running, there was a lot to reminisce about. Team members at the event represented multiple generations of Haiti Plunge participants, including some members from the very first teams in 1984. It was a great opportunity for old and new members to reconnect, share stories and give updates about the developments that have happened in our nine partner villages throughout the years.

The event included a photo slide show of the early years, a memory book for Team Members to contribute their stories to, and a traditional meal of rice and beans. In a post-reunion reflection, Sr. Eunice Tassone wrote: "Aug. 1st turned out to be a memorable reunion for [members] near and as far away as California."

For me, it was a bit overwhelming to see some of the 'kids' who actually founded the Haiti Plunge. It was a day of laughter, telling funny stories and enjoying each other's company."

The reunion also highlighted how dedicated Seamless Team members are. As a result of the event three primary school students and two secondary students were sponsored to go to school this fall and many hand crafted bags and bracelets were purchased. Your continued support for the organization and to our Haitian partners is truly what has kept this program running for 31 years. We look forward to seeing you all next year at our 2nd Annual Reunion (or before then in Haiti)!

On September 12 the Progressive Palette of Williamstown, MA hosted a fundraising event for the Haiti Plunge at Mongo's Sports Bar and Grill in North Adams, MA. Participants in this fundraising painting class learned to paint a picture of the Cabaret Mountains in Haiti while supporting the Haiti Plunge. With a portion of ticket proceeds donated to the Haiti Plunge, as well as a Haitian craft basket raffle, the organization was able to raise \$120 for school and educational initiatives in our partner villages.

The August team spent several days working with the people in Brely to build benches for the classrooms. The second graders from St. Mary's School in Lee, MA raised the money for this project. The school was finished this past summer and will be open to students in September. Because the village of Brely is high up in the mountains it took several years to build. The greatest challenge was transporting supplies which had to be delivered in between the rainy seasons. The school will serve hundreds of children from smaller villages higher in the mountains. There are no other schools within a five mile radius.
