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Rainwater Collection Project has begun to bring clean water to Brely

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Rainwater Collection Project



Haiti Plunge Inc. serves nine isolated mountain villages with little or no road access resulting in lack of running water or electricity. HPI serves a population of approximately 38,000 spanning a 25-mile radius. In April of 2019, HPI initiated the Rainwater Collection Project in the village of Brely. It installed its first unit. Each unit consists of a cement base platform, PVC pipe for gutters, wood frame, 500 gallon water tank and a bio-sand filter for water purification. The per unit cost is \$1,145. The goal is to install 12 units in the village of Brely. They will be placed on the roofs of the school, team residence and church roofs. The total cost for the Brely project will be \$ 13,740. Once the units are in place and underground cistern will be put in and the overflow from the tanks will be piped into this cistern for storage. The population will have options as to how to utilize this water supply.

Matwon Education Program Graduates 12

A 22-week program Initiated for the purpose of educating the village birthing attendants skill levels. In April, thirteen participants graduated the program. Two members from every village have been selected for the 2020 program which will begin in January. Dr. Gabrielle Cajuste has been hired to direct the program.



Pillowcase Dresses for Haiti Grows



Linda Reardon, the project coordinator has organized 18 volunteers to help her make the dresses which are distributed throughout the nine villages. What started out as dresses has expanded to include shorts for boys and skirts. Almost 300 dresses have been made in just the one year that Linda initiated the program.



As an acknowledgement for their hours of work, HPI held a volunteer dinner on Nov. 13th for them at the Manor in Adams. The women were able to plan the direction they want to go in 2020.

School Sponsorships Numbers Grew in 2019



School Sponsorship Program was able to provide scholarships for over 200 children in the six village schools that HPI supports. Parents are handed an envelope with money to purchase the child's uniform and school supplies. HPI pays the tuition for each student directly to the Director of each school.

Giving Tree Program Aids in Food and Education Stability

In keeping with the mission of HPI to provide resources that support sustainable development, the Giving Tree Project:

- provides an additional food source for their family
- an income to pay for a child's education
- provides a root system to prevent further erosion in a farming community that experiences 1% erosion annually.

Due to the fact that lemons are in high demand in Haiti, a mixture of lemon and mango trees were distributed. 218 trees distributed in 2019.



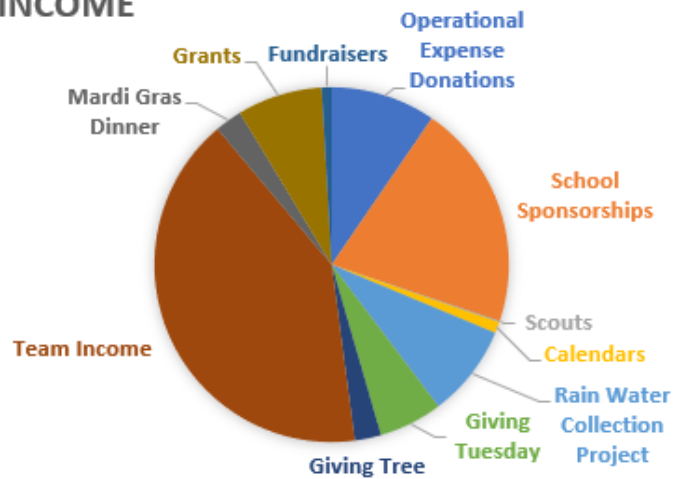
Storage Room Construction Began

More storage space is needed to accommodate HPI equipment. An addition attached to the existing structure has been started and will be completed in February 2020 when HPI team masons will be in Haiti.

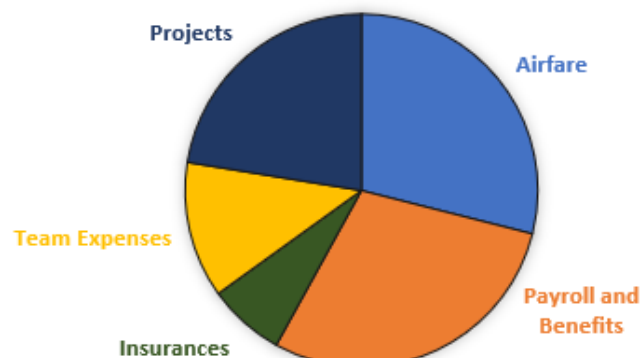
