From March to August children from the nine villages that Haiti Plunge Inc. serves ate their one daily meal inside their churches or schools. Due to a drought that destroyed their family's crops there was no food in the villages. Thanks to the generosity of HPI donors, thousands of children were fed a meal of rice and beans cooked by village women.

This program is no longer needed because crops are being harvested. The people in our villages are filled with gratitude for saving their children with this life saving gift.

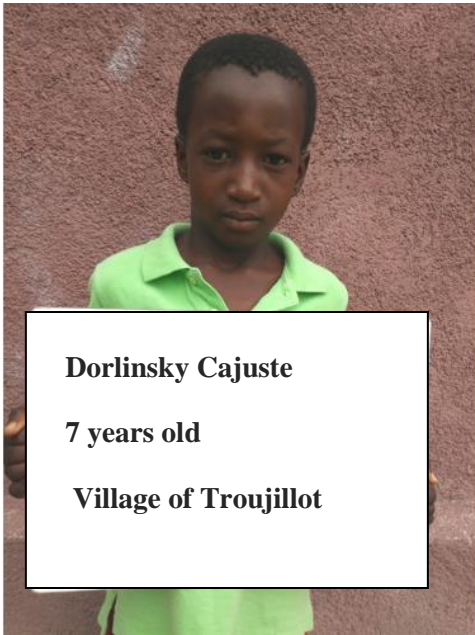

Child Sponsorship Program

There are many children in the nine villages that Haiti Plunge Inc. serves that do not have the opportunity to attend school because their families cannot afford to pay school tuition. Some families alternate children and send one every other year. Haiti has no public school system and families in the mountains live on less than \$5.00 a day for a family of four. They grow all their own food. A recent drought destroyed all their crops. Sponsoring a child is the greatest gift a child can receive. Haitian children consider it an honor to go to school. The cost of an annual sponsorship is \$100.. Anyone interested can make a check payable to Haiti Plunge/ SP. A photo of the child being sponsored will be sent.
